

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

QUIZ CONTEST during 'Loyalty Breakfast – Ho Chi Minh City' conference

The Controller of personal data is Comarch S.A., having its principal place of business at Aleja Jana Pawła II 39A, 31-864 Kraków, Poland. The Controller has appointed the Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at: iod@comarch.pl.

The purpose of processing personal data of the Participant is to organize and conduct the Quiz Contest – a contest organized by the Controller at the “Loyalty Breakfast – Ho Chi Minh City” conference in Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam, hereinafter referred to as the “Quiz Contest”. Personal data processed by the Controller for the abovementioned purpose include the name or nickname used by the Participant during the registration of the participation in the Quiz Contest by logging in through the Kahoot application.

The legal basis for processing personal data of the Participant is Article 6 paragraph 1 point (a) of the GDPRⁱ - a consent given by the data subject to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes. Participation in the Quiz Contest and the giving consent to the processing of personal data is voluntary and can be withdrawn at any time. Providing personal data is voluntary, but it is necessary to achieve the goals specified above for which the data were collected. Withdrawing of the consent to the processing of personal data is considered as a resignation from participation in the Quiz Contest.

In order to withdraw the consent, please send a relevant statement using the contact details provided above. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the personal data processing prior to the withdrawal of the consent.

The data shall be processed for the period necessary to organize and conduct the Quiz Contest.

The Winners of the Quiz Contest selected in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations of the Quiz Contest will be asked to provide additional personal data including their name and surname, ID Card number, e-mail address or phone number by completing the 'Protocol of receipt' of the prize.

The purpose of processing the personal data in this case is the necessity to fulfill tax obligations to which the Organizer is subject and the legal basis for processing of personal data is Article 6 paragraph 1 point (c) of the GDPR - processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary to receive the prize.

In this case, the data shall be processed for the period necessary to perform the legal obligations of the Controller, which arises from the Controller's national laws.

The data is not subject to profiling by the Administrator as well as the data provided will not be processed for automated decision-making.

In accordance with the provisions of the GDPR, the person whose personal data is processed has the right to access to his or her personal data, right to rectification, right to erasure ('right to be forgotten'), right to restriction of processing, right to data portability, right to object (where the controller's legitimate interest is the basis for data processing), right to withdraw consent (where consent is the basis for data processing). The exercise of these rights is subject to the conditions set out in the GDPR.

The provided personal data may be made available to suppliers, service providers and partners of companies from the Comarch Group to the extent necessary to service the activities of the Comarch Group companies.

Therefore, we would like to inform that the Participants' personal data may be transferred to a non-EU country. In the event of transferring data to a third country in relation to which no decision of the European Commission has been issued stating an appropriate degree of protection, companies from the Comarch Group apply appropriate safeguards through standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Commission or supervisory authority (in accordance with Article 46 paragraph 2 points c) and d) of the GDPR. In case of finding an infringement of the provisions of the GDPR, the Participant may lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland.

ⁱ REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)
